#### Treasurer Report:

Current bank balance in the PNC bank account is \$9,524.09 and \$734.46 in paypal account. Total expenditures since last month total \$23,811.81 (1129.99 robot parts, 3692.11 ftc expenses, 750 entry fee IRI, 1259.11 team banquet, 2516.64 awards banquet, 1293.54 school bus expenses travel, 9065.25 hotel worlds, 194.24 gas to pull trailer, 185.21 travel expenses worlds, 284.70 scrip sale expenses, 2043.75 spirit purchases, 620 liability insurance, and 777.27 non engineering expenses). Deposits made since last meeting (990 student fees, 461 ftc contributions, 2000 corporate donations, 1000 summer camp profits, 1130.16 profit golf tournament, 522.50 collected from scrips sales, 414.40 travel reimbursements, 801.30 candy sales, 698.22 misc. donations) Expenses expected to hit next month robot parts, kickoff and non engineering (outreach) and deposits expected student fees (FTC) corporate donations and grants.

Budget was presented to parent group for 2015-2016 season. Budget was reviewed and will be voted on at next parent meeting Sept. 24<sup>th</sup>. Student fees will be \$500.00 this year and roughly \$100.00 travel fees. Payments will be due Nov 1<sup>st</sup> (100.00), Dec 1<sup>st</sup> (100.00) and Jan 7<sup>th</sup> (300.00) with travel fees due roughly 2 weeks before actual travel.

Team will be having a fall mum sell (students will get \$6.20 per mum sold towards fee) pick up date Sept. 18<sup>th</sup>.
