Ryan was now sad because he couldn't help work on the coolest tree house ever. As he walked away, Sarah the Squirrel noticed and asked, "Why the long face?"








As Ryan sobbed, "First I got a splinter, then I dropped the hammer on my foot, and I fell out of the tree house!"
